Rattlesnake vaccine for \$24 per dose will be available .

You have probably heard about the new rattlesnake-venom vaccine. For more information on the vaccine please check the Internet at www.redrockbiologics.com. The literature suggests that while this vaccine may help reduce trauma from a rattlesnake bite, it is no substitute for de-snaking your dog. Your dog's natural curiosity is his enemy when he shows interest in *any* snake! While the vaccine available at the printing of this announcement is available against only rattlesnakes, de-snaking your dog can help prevent his injury by any snake, as dogs learn to identify the danger with not only by hearing the snake, but by smelling it, and by seeing it.

We will be de-snaking rain or shine. We do not take reservations. Simply show up with your dog or dogs during the hours listed above, and we will take care of the rest! Service is on a first-come first-served basis.

If your dog is in training or boarding with us, or will be at the time of the de-snaking, please ask if we would recommend that he/she be de-snaked at this time.

Directions: **From Houston**, take I-10 west past Katy and past Brookshire to exit #723 (San Felipe, Stephen F. Austin State Park and F.M. 1458). At the stop sign at the end of the feeder road, go right, onto F.M. 1458, going north. Check your odometer. We are 4 miles north on the left side of the road. There is a big sign out front for the kennel.

From Columbus: take I-10 east to exit #723. Turn left at the stop sign, onto F.M. 1458 north, going over the interstate We are 4.1 miles from the stop sign where you turned, on the left side of the road.

Please watch your speed going through San Felipe!
